Museum Purchases Property



The National Corvette Museum has purchased the 7.5 acre Fraternal Order of Police Lodge No. 13 property at 150 Corvette Drive. The land, adjacent to Museum owned property, was originally owned by the NCM but has been home to the 8,000 square foot FOP Lodge for the past 17 years.

The new NCM Collections Building will be used for office space for the Collections team, and storage of a growing collection of donated cars and other items.

2020 Stingray Pricing Announced

With its new mid-engine configuration and sleek, modern design, the 2020 Chevrolet Corvette Stingray offers unprecedented performance at a starting price of \$59,995 (including Destination Freight Charge of \$1,095, excluding tax, title, license, dealer fees and optional equipment).

The 1LT will start at \$59,995, the 2LT trim package will start at \$67,295 and the top-level 3LT trim package on the 2020 Corvette Stingray will start at \$71,945 (including DFC, excluding tax, title, license, dealer fees and optional equipment). One Lap of Kentucky Registration Open



Each fall the National Corvette Museum partners with the Kentucky State Police for a series of back-to-back road trips, taking participants through the countryside. The 2019 trip will be based in Danville, Kentucky and features visits to Wilderness Trail Distillery, Old Harrod State Park, White Hall State Historic Site, Old Town Artisan Village, Rebecca Ruth Candy, Old Friends Equine (race horse retirement farm) and more.

Proceeds from the trip are split between the Museum and KSP's Trooper Island Camp for underprivileged kids. Cost is \$1,200 for primary registrant (member) or \$1240 for non-member. Passenger is \$450 (member) or \$490 (non-member).
