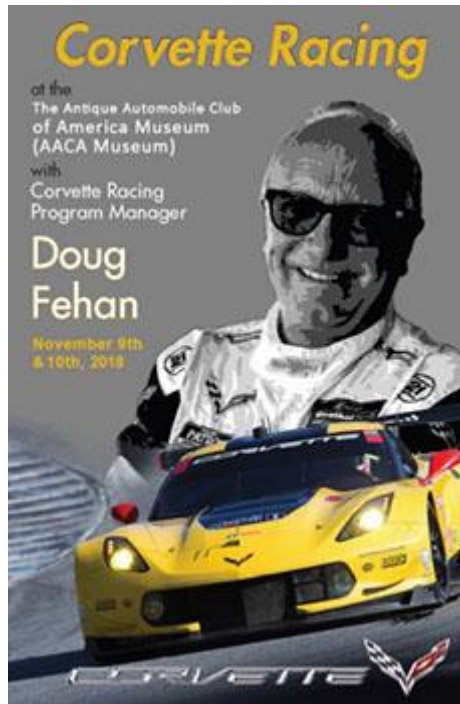

Get Coached by Andy Pilgrim

How would you like to get coached by race car driver Andy Pilgrim? One-on-one sessions (up to two drivers per day) are available and include private track time at the NCM Motorsports Park, Andy setting a data lap, takeaway data and analysis via VBOX. Lunch is included for both one and two day sessions. Dinner is included on the first day for two day sessions. Sessions are 9am-5pm CST.

Cost is \$3,000 for one day in your car or \$5,500 for two days in your car. This program is also available with the use of our car for \$6,000 for one day and \$11,000 for two days.

Group sessions are available for up to five drivers and include private track time, instructional classroom time, and takeaway data and analysis. Lunch is included. One day with your car is \$10,000.



Chevrolet Racing: Louis to LeMans

Beginning June 11, the Museum's Exhibit Hall will once again be transformed to feature a special themed display. For a period of about seven months, that theme is Chevrolet racing history.

The story of Chevrolet racing will be told from the early days of Louis Chevrolet as a racing driver for Buick, through the AMA ban on racing, to Chevrolet Racing's involvement in NASCAR, to the Le Mans winning Corvettes. Significant stories will be told through the display of various cars and artifacts, from engines including one from a C5-R, and a fuel injection cutaway, to race suits, trophies from various races and more. The exhibit will run until January 4, 2019.
