Message from the Chair of the National Corvette Museum

The National Corvette Museum takes very seriously our role in serving our Members and the entire Corvette community. We realize the impact membership has made on everything from the success of our events to the long-term stability of the Museum. We also thank you for your work and support as an NCM Ambassador. You are vital in providing Museum news, support, and information to the incredible network of Corvette Clubs coast-to-coast.

With this responsibility in mind, we wanted to directly address the online petition about an internal National Corvette Museum staff matter. Out of respect for our Clubs and Members, we are providing clarity on inaccuracies in the petition and address specifics on the process.

How is the National Corvette Museum Leadership Currently Structured?

With the absence of a current CEO at the Museum, the Board of Directors appointed the Executive Committee as the interim CEO. While the Board of Directors is not traditionally involved in any staffing decisions outside of the CEO level, currently the Executive Committee has all the responsibilities associated with the CEO, including staff decisions. This structure will be in place until we identify a full-time CEO.

How did the NCM approach this particular situation?

During challenging situations in any business, it is paramount that leadership recognize formal concerns from employees and take them seriously. When these situations arise, investigations are required, followed by appropriate due diligence. When the process is complete, a thorough review is conducted.

These best practices were followed, including a full review of all investigation findings by the Board of Directors. The entire Board had full visibility into the situation and delegated the decision to the Executive Committee as the interim CEO.

Looking Ahead

Change can be uncomfortable, but sharing the facts and process to demonstrate our intentions are fair, just, and done with due diligence allows us to move forward.

We trust and value the role our Ambassadors and Members have in the success of the Museum and ask that you take the same responsibility for the news you share with your club. You are welcome to send this communication to your Corvette Club members and stakeholders to clear up any questions.
